

PRIVACY STATEMENT

Article 1. Company data

The private company Catch22 B.V., Its registered office in Helmond, 5708 ZT, the Broederwal 11, represented by Jan Teun Koningen hereinafter referred to as: Catch22.

Article 2. Personal data

Catch22 processes personal data from you, because you use our services and/or because you provide this information to us. Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- Name and surname;
- Gender;
- Date of birth;
- Birthplace;
- Address;
- Phone number.

Article 4. Processing purposes/Lawful basis

The above mentioned personal data are processed for the following purposes:

- Personnel administration;
- Services delivery or the delivery of products;
- Distribution of newsletter and/or advertising;
- Run and drafting of an agreement;
- Security and optimisation of the website (e.g. for capturing IP addresses).

CATCH22 processes personal data on the basis of the consent of persons.

Article 5. Retention period

Catch22 will not keep the collected personal data any longer than is strictly necessary, or is legally regulated, to realize the purposes for which the data has been collected. For the personal data for which statutory retention periods apply, CATCH22 adheres to the statutory retention periods.

Article 6. Share with third parties

In principle, Catch22 does not provide data to third parties. Catch22 will only provide your information to third parties if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement or to comply with a legal obligation. If we disclose your information to third parties for other reasons, we are obliged to ask you for permission first. Where relevant, a processing

contract shall be concluded with such third parties, or it shall be verified whether that party is properly handling the personal data. CATCH22 remains responsible for these processing (s).

The following personal data are in any case provided to third parties: personnel data are transferred to the payroll administration, as this is necessary for the salary processing.

Article 7. Security

Catch22 takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, and other undesirable acts with personal data. These measures are in accordance with the applicable security standards.

Article 8. Rights of data subjects

You have the right to view, correct, supplement, delete and/or object to the use of your personal data. To do so, please make an appointment with CATCH22 (more specifically Jan Teun Koningen) or you can send an e-mail to info@catch22.nu. The filing of a complaint is possible with the appropriate authorities, “de Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens”. You also have the option of withdrawing your consent to the processing of personal data. For this you need an appointment with CATCH22 (more specifically Jan Teun Koningen) or you can send an e-mail to info@catch22.nu. It is important that you can legitimize yourself and prove that the data you want to see, correct or delete is actually yours. It is not allowed to view data from other people.

Article 9. Cookies

CATCH22 uses functional and/or Technical cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone on the first visit to this website. The cookies we use are necessary to optimize our website. You can opt out of cookies by setting your Internet browser to not store cookies. In addition, you can also delete any information previously saved from the browser settings.

You can sign up for our various newsletters. This way you stay informed about our offers, promotions and our news. We have general and personal newsletters. We compose the personal newsletters based on your information, such as previous orders. That makes the newsletter more interesting for you.
